

iOS - How to get the device UDID

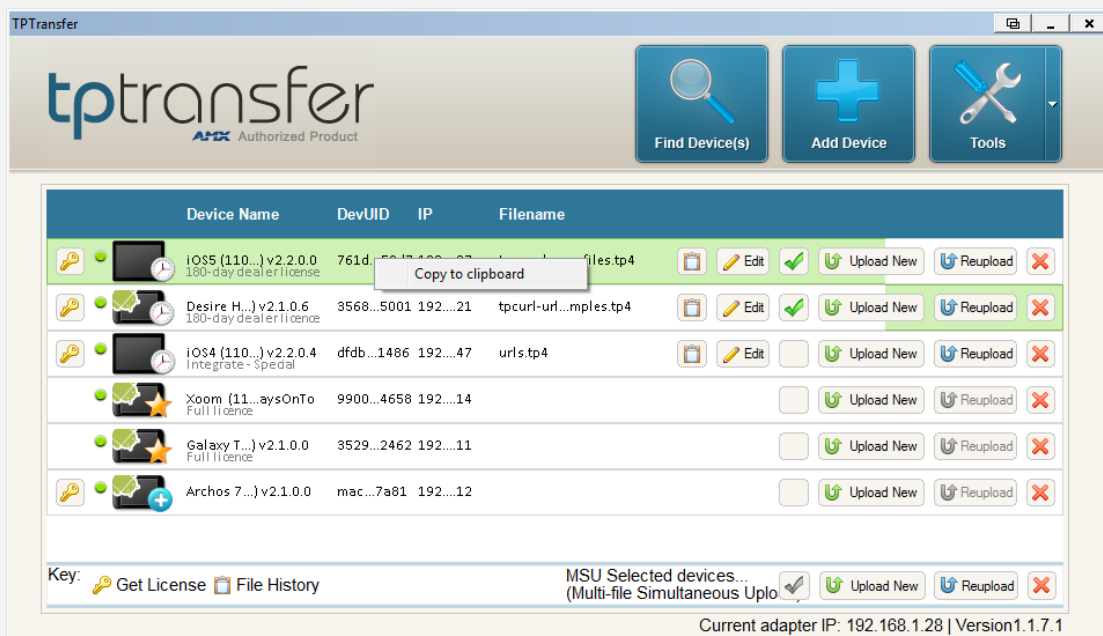
Copy/Paste from TPTransfer (v1.1.7.1+)

1. Launch TPTransfer on your computer. TPTransfer is available as a free download from www.touchpanelcontrol.com



2. Ensure that TPCControl is installed and running on your device. Any located devices will appear in the TPTransfer device list.

3. Using your mouse, right-button-click the DevUID field to present the “Copy to clipboard” dialog, then left-click the “Copy to clipboard” option.



4. You can now paste the UDID into an email application or web browser by selecting “Edit” and then “Paste” from the file menu of the program. Alternatively press “Ctrl+V” in a text area.

Copy/Paste from iTunes

1. Launch iTunes and connect your device to the computer.
2. Select your device from the "Devices" list in the left hand column under the "Devices" section. A field called "Serial Number" will be presented in the main window under the "Summary" tab. Click the field once, which cycles the field name to "Identifier (UDID)"



3. A field called "Serial Number" will be presented in the main window. Click the field once, which cycles the field name to "Identifier (UDID)".



4. Click the "Edit" menu option, and select "Copy", this will apply the UDID to the Clipboard.



5. You can now paste the UDID into an email application or web browser by selecting **“Edit”** and then **“Paste”** from the file menu of the program. Alternatively press **“Ctrl+V”** in a text area.
