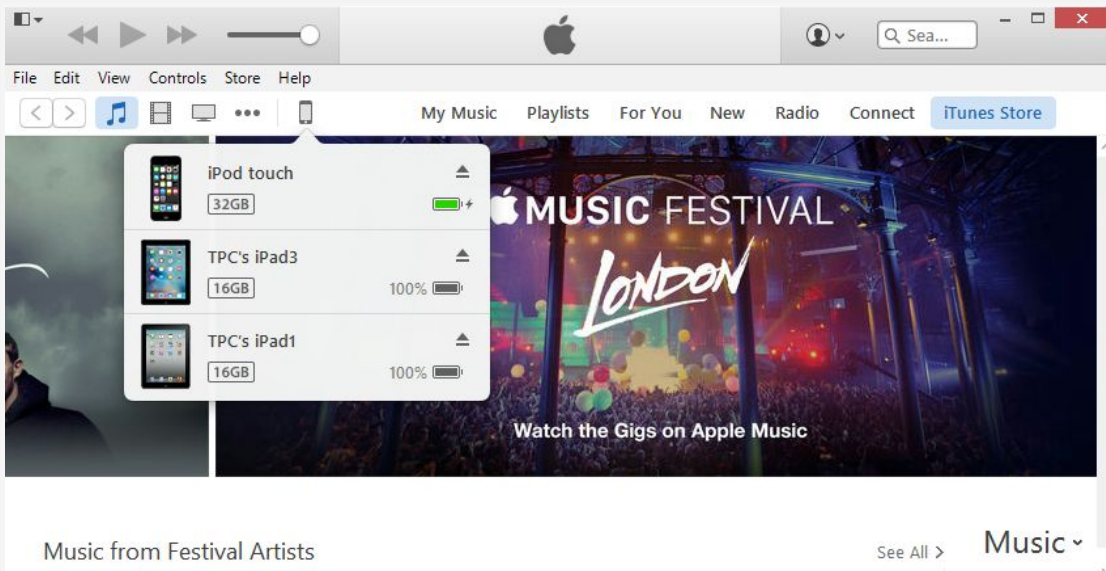


# iOS - How to get the device UDID

## Newer versions of iTunes:

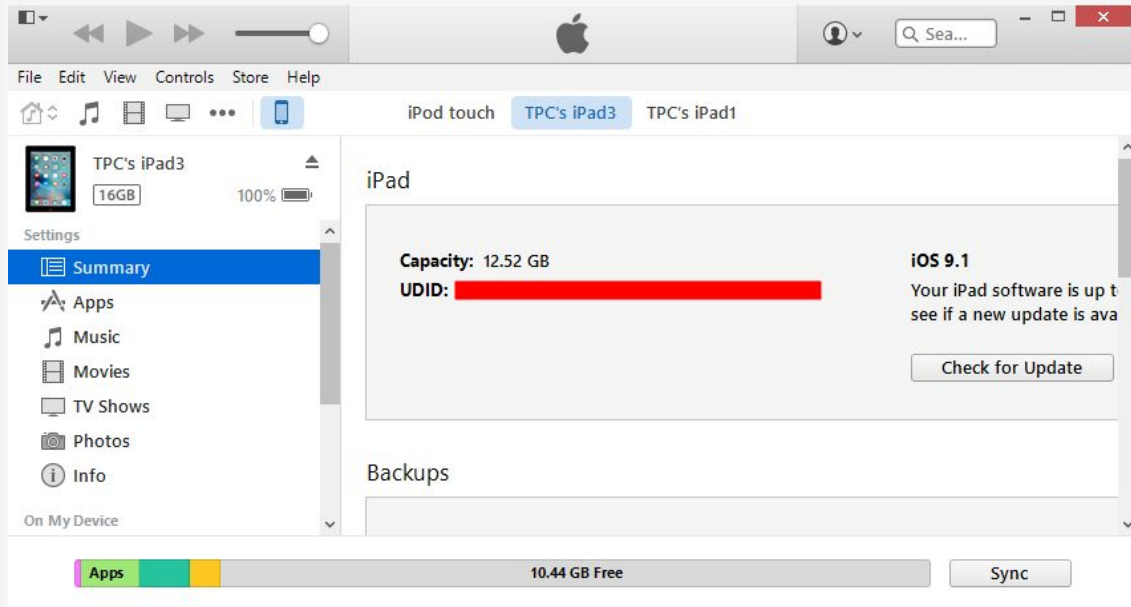
1. Launch iTunes and connect your device to the computer.
2. Click the **Device** icon, and select your device from the **Device** drop-down list.



3. Under the **Summary** option, a field called **Serial Number** will be presented.



4. Click the **Serial Number** field once, which cycles the field name to **UDID**.



5. Press **CTRL+C** (or click the **Edit** menu option *if showing*, followed by **Copy UDID**). This will apply the UDID to the Clipboard.
6. Now paste the UDID value into your preferred application using the **Edit > Paste** option, or **Ctrl+V**.

## Older versions of iTunes:

1. Launch iTunes and connect your device to the computer.
2. Select your device from the **Devices** list in the left hand column under the **Devices** section. A field called **Serial Number** will be presented in the main window under the **Summary** tab.



3. Click the **Serial Number** field once, which cycles the field name to **Identifier (UDID)**.



4. Press **CTRL+C** (or click the **Edit** menu option, and select **Copy**).  
This will apply the UDID value to the Clipboard.



5. Now paste the UDID value into your preferred application using the **Edit > Paste** option, or **Ctrl+V**.
